CORRECTIVE ACTION: DISCREPANCIES IN WEEK 25 COVID-19 WEEKLY **EPIDEMIOLOGY BRIEF**

AfriForum is a civil rights organisation with more than 247 000 individual members. The AfriForum Research Institute (ANI) uses the COVID-19 Weekly Epidemiology Brief released by the NICD for analysis and to keep our members and the public in general informed and calm. However, when comparing the briefs of week 24 (ending 13 June) and week 25 (ending 20 June), we identified discrepancies that require your urgent correction.

Total number of cases

When comparing the total number of cases for week 24 and week 25, it is evident that there is a decrease in the total number of cases for the age group 55-59 (kindly see the numbers highlighted in red in Table 1.) This is impossible, as the total number of people infected with COVID-19 cannot decrease over time.

New cases

When calculating the new cases for week 25 (based on the numbers provided in the reports), it does not add up to the same number of new cases as indicated in the week 25 report. For the age groups between 5 and 29 years, the reported new cases are less than the calculated cases. On the other hand, the reported new cases are more than the calculated for the age groups between 30 and 59 years old. There are no differences for the age groups 0–4 and 60+ years old. Kindly refer to Table 2.

Percentage of new cases

When comparing the reported percentage new cases with the calculated percentages, the discrepancies are similar to those of the new cases described above. Kindly see Table 3.

We therefore request that -

- 1. The week 25 report be withdrawn, and a notice published of the withdrawal;
- 2. That all discrepancies in the report be identified and corrected, and the report republished;
- 3. The cause of the discrepancies be identified, and steps taken to prevent a reoccurrence of such an error; and
- 4. AfriForum be informed of the cause of the discrepancies and the preventative steps taken.

Your urgent attention in this regard is appreciated.
